- submits the Scholarship Agreement Form and its scholarship funds to the Office of Financial Aid, postmarked **by August 1** (for students starting in fall), **by December 1** (for students starting in spring), or **by May 1** (for students starting in summer).

By signing, church representatives attest that ...

- The church has established and approved the scholarship program.
- A scholarship committee (or equivalent) makes awards using church-approved guidelines.
- Scholarship funds come from the annual budget, endowed sources, or a special scholarship fund. If a special fund is created, contributions will be given to the fund and not to individuals. **Students and/or families will not contribute to the special fund** (and thus gain benefits from their giving).
- The church maintains a formal mentoring or residency experience for each student.
