

MFT Practicum Qualifying Exams Guidelines For 2009/2010 Practicum

In order to begin providing therapy services to clients it is vital to possess a working knowledge of MFT theories. The MFT Practicum Qualifying Exams provide students the opportunity to demonstrate that level of competence.

Students are encouraged to thoroughly prepare for the exams, as passing the tests are a requirement for admission to practicum. Students will have three opportunities to pass both the objective and essay exams.

Details:

- A timed 1 hour objective exam
- A timed 1 hour essay exam
- ESL students may have more time by **prior** arrangement with the MFT program administrator

Passing:

- A minimum of 70% is required to pass both the objective exam and the essay exam
